The Lord Strathcona Trust Fund Medal

The Lord Strathcona Trust Fund Medal, most commonly referred to as the Lord Strathcona Medal is the highest award, which can be bestowed upon a cadet in recognition of exemplary performance in physical and military training.

Lord Strathcona's objectives in establishing his endowment were to:

- a. encourage the improvement of the physical and intellectual capabilities of cadets;
- b. foster patriotism in cadets through the acquisition of a good knowledge of military matters.

The recipient must have a complete knowledge of the activities of the cadet movement and must meet the following requirements:

- a. have a high level of physical fitness;
- b. have qualified to a training level of at least Level 3 (completed level 3)
- c. have met all requirements of their corps' mandatory training program and attended at least 75 per cent of the scheduled training parades in the year
- d. have met all requirements of their corps' optional/support training program and attended at least 60 per cent of the scheduled activities
- e. have completed three years as a cadet,
- f. be regarded by peers and supervisors as exemplifying the model cadet

To apply for the Lord Strathcona Trust Fund Medal you must:

- Write a narrative as to your qualifications for the Medal
- Create a resume
- Obtain 2 letters of reference
